




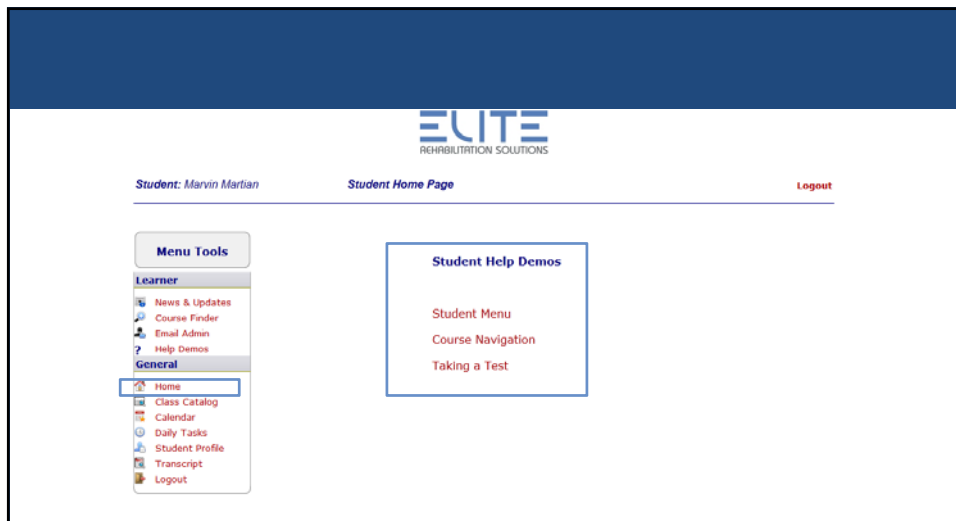
You must first create a login username (your email address) and password. Click on “New Students: Click here for registration.”

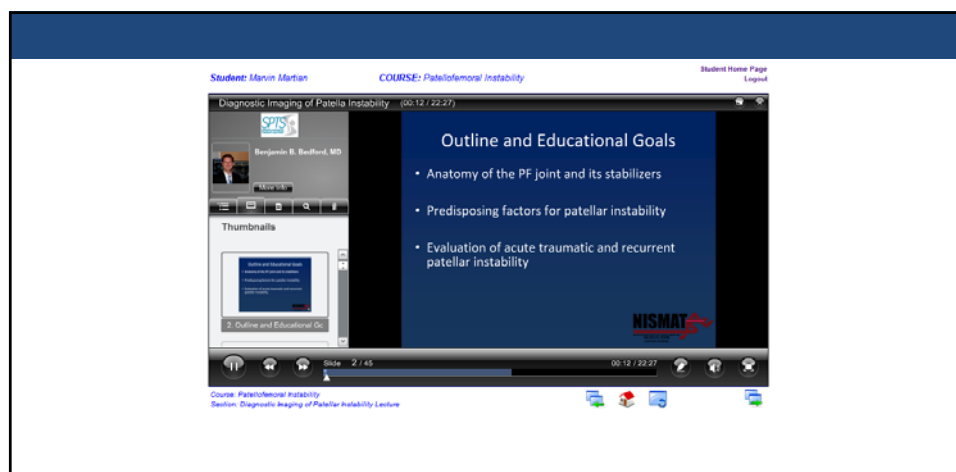
Be sure to click the “Classes-Enrolled” tab. Click “Enter” to begin the course.



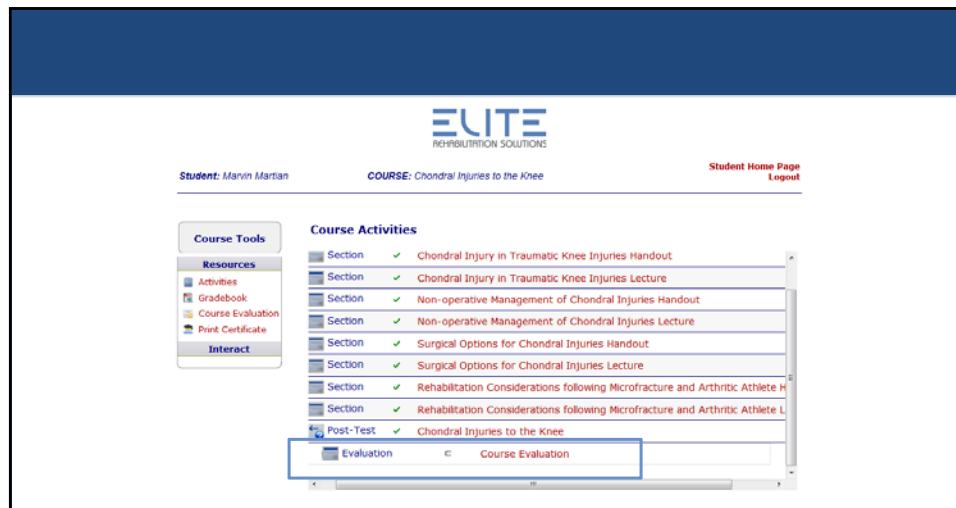

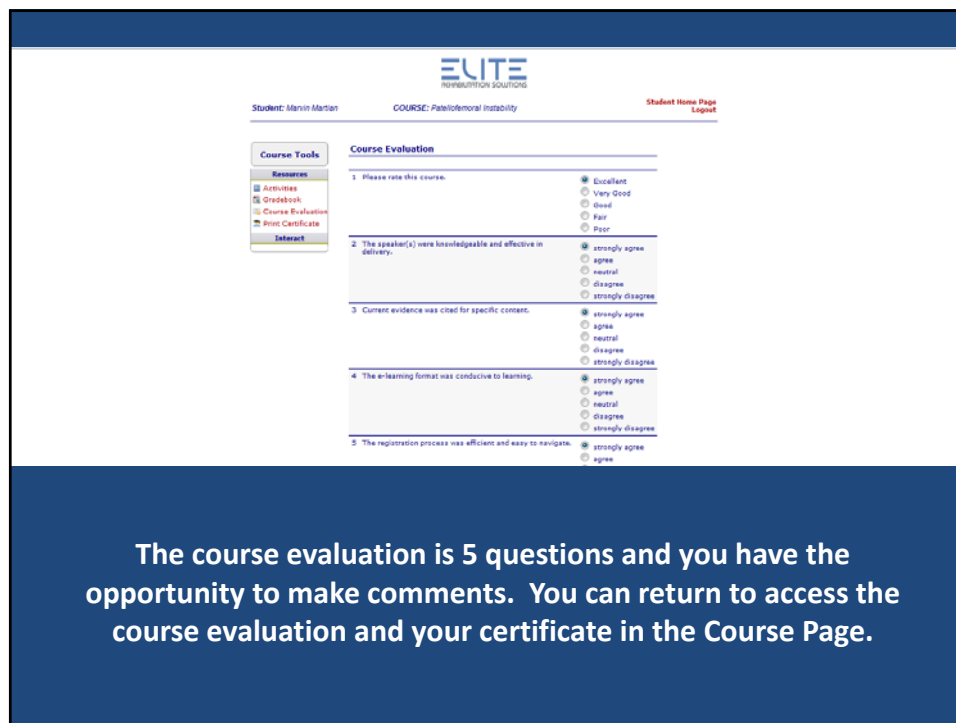
